Subject: Maximum and Minimum Pass Marks for Higher Secondary Part-1st (Class 11th)

The minimum No. of marks required to pass the examination in each part in Humanities, Science, Home Science and Commerce shall be as under:-

As per standing regulations, the percentage of passing marks is 33% in General English and 36% in each of the remaining four (04) elective subjects opted by the candidate. In a subject in which there is a practical examination, the percentage of marks required to be obtained by a candidate shall be 36% in theory and practicals, (Separately in the practical test and Internal Assessment) and 36% in the aggregate of theory and practical"
